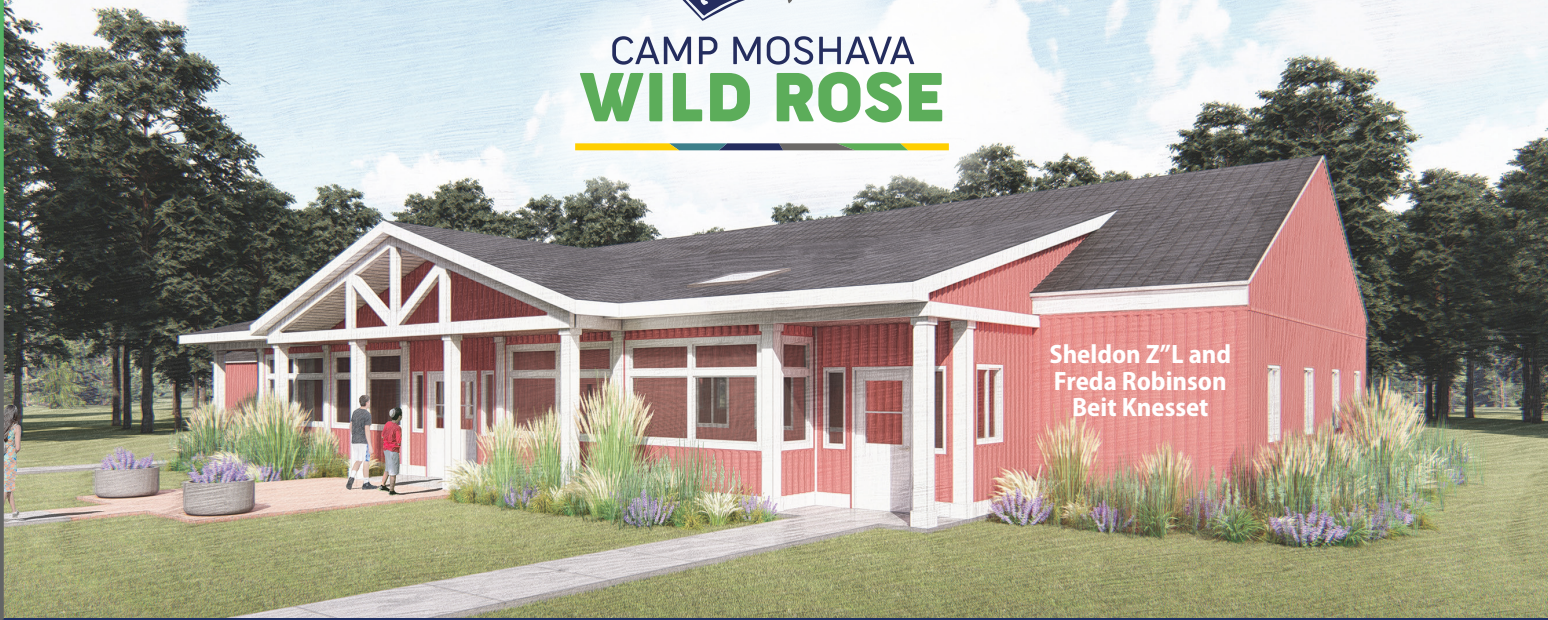

- *Remodeled Kitchens* with upgraded equipment and facilities to meet the needs of all campers including those with food allergies
- *Ventilation in Cabins* to enhance camper and staff comfort
- *Boys Bathroom on Avodah* to accommodate growing programs
- *Remodeled Arts and Crafts Facility* to enhance the arts programming
- *Updated Beachfront and Dock* to enhance the outdoor lake experiences
- *New Gazebo* to foster community and support programming
- *New Gameroom* with air conditioning to provide an additional fun gathering space and foster comradery amongst the campers
